September- October	I am scheduled into the correct courses. I am registered for the correct advanced academics exam where applicable and committed to doing my best on the exam in the Spring.

Weekly	I logon to Home Access Center regularly to check my grades and assignments. I correspond with my teacher to ensure complete understanding of assignments and upcoming deadlines. Ongoing	I take the initiative to access available resources designed to support my learning. I seek help before my grade drops below a "B". I actively and productively engage in class and meaningfully interact with the content of the course. I follow through with the opportunity to and parameters for retaking assessments. I use the results of my formative assessments to guide my learning.
3 or more Times per Semester	I have engaged in extended learning opportunities to assist me with developing the skills and strategies necessary for high academic achievement in my courses and to do well on assessments and exams. Extended Learning Opportunities are classes, workshops, tutoring, etc. which extend beyond the regular school day either early morning, after school, or weekends.
